

#### UPDATES IN OTOLARYNGOLOGY SYMPOSIUM

The 12th Annual ENT in the Desert Symposium offers practicing otolaryngologists lectures and interactive panels focused on general topics of Head and Neck Surgery, Laryngology, Otology, Pediatrics, Rhinology/Allergy and Facial Plastic Surgery. Taught by internationally renowned experts, the symposium is for general otolaryngologists, residents, physician extenders and primary care physicians interested in otolaryngology. Many of the state's prominent academicians will be lecturing at this course.

#### **EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES**

- Apply the latest interventional and diagnostic technologies for the management of HPV-associated head and neck cancer.
- Manage obstructive sleep apnea using appropriate guidelines for surgical intervention for this disease.
- Utilize surgical or biologic therapies for the management of chronic rhinosinusitis with nasal polyposis.
- Avoid/manage complications of endoscopic sinus surgery, including CSF leaks.
- Manage dyspnea related to upper airway stenosis.
- Incorporate lasers appropriately in office-based otolaryngology practice.
- Manage hearing loss in adults.
- Manage allergic rhinosinusitis in the pediatric population.
